

## How to record using the MicroMEMO digital audio recorder and the iPod video.



### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Turn the ipod on by pressing any button.
- 2) Connect the MicroMEMO to the base of the iPod (it clicks into place with the logo facing forward). There are no batteries or cables to worry about, the MicroMEMO runs off the ipod battery.
- 3) Ensure that the microphone is properly clicked into the MicroMEMO base unit.
- 4) The recording dialogue (shown in image above) appears automatically when the base unit is attached (provided the iPod is turned on).
- 5) If it does not (for example, if you turn the iPod on with the MicroMEMO already attached), using the scroll-wheel, select **Menu >> Extras >> Voice Memos**
- 6) Lay the iPod flat on its back and point the microphone roughly in the direction of the subjects.
- 7) Press **'Record'**
- 8) Press **'Stop and Save'** when you are finished. The ipod automatically saves your recording with the date and time it was created.

## PLAYING A RECORDING

Select **Extras >> Voice Memos** and select the recording.

**Note:** The Voice Memos menu item doesn't appear until you connect a microphone.

## TRANSFERRING A RECORDING TO A COMPUTER

### Manually

Voice memos are saved in a Recordings folder on iPod in the WAV file format. If you enable iPod for disk use, you can drag voice memos from the folder to copy them.

### Synchronizing

If iPod is set to update songs automatically and you record voice memos, the voice memos are automatically downloaded to a playlist in iTunes when you connect iPod. Once downloaded, the voice memos are removed from the Voice Memos folder on your iPod. To play the voice memos that have been synchronized to your computer in iTunes, select the Voice Memos playlist in the iTunes Source pane. To play the synchronized voice memos on the iPod, select the Voice Memos playlist in the Music menu, not the Voice Memos menu in the Extras menu.
